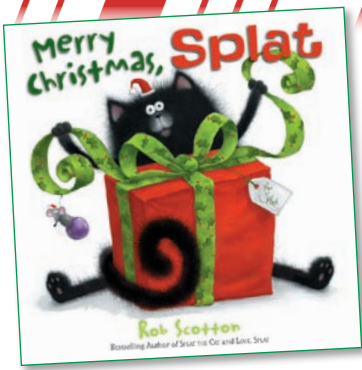

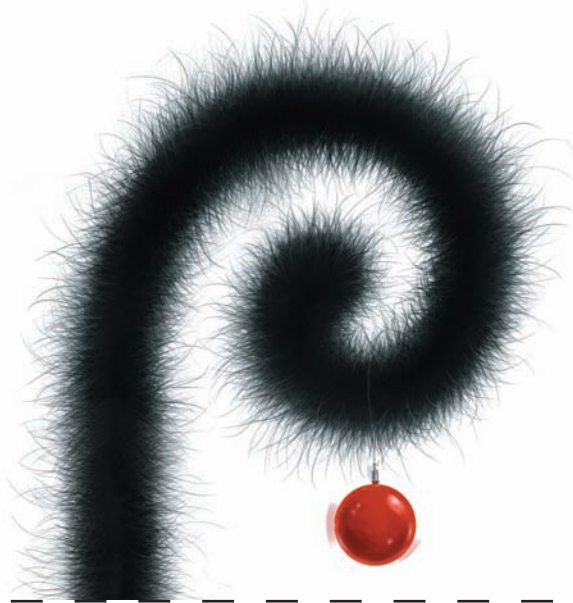


Holiday Greetings!

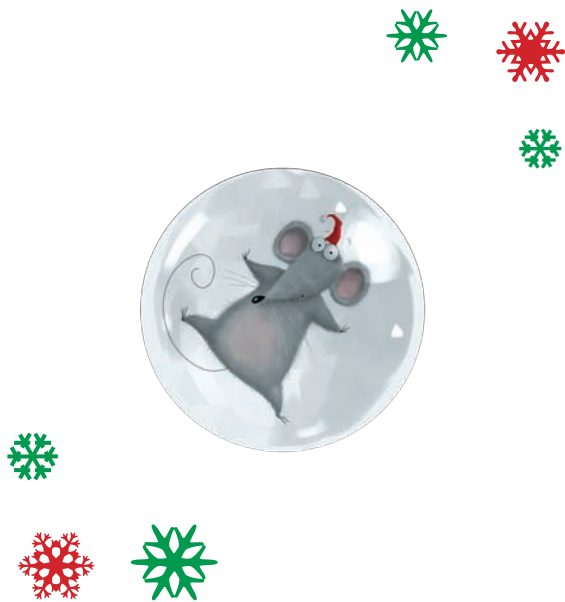

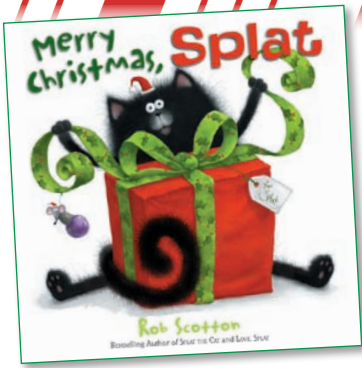
