Mask

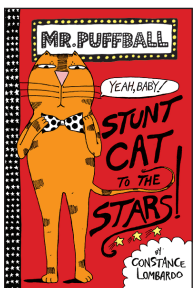
Even if it's just a strip of fabric with eyeholes, this is an essential for masked vigilantes, cat burglars, and superheroes.
