

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

Benny the woodpecker loves waffles! Below are his suggestions for making your waffle taste wonderful!




Looking for something sweet?

- Avocado






Story Time Tips

Make the most of reading Woodpecker Wants a Waffle aloud with these tips below!

- 1) Voice Matters. Try using a different voice for each of the characters in the book.
- 2) **Sound Effects.** Words like "FWAP!" "BAP!" and "SWOOSH!" should be read aloud with gusto.
- 3) Act It Out. Ask your child to act out the story with you! Take turns picking specific scenes and characters.





- 4) Ask Questions. Pause while reading the story and ask your child questions about the plot, character motivations, and images in the book.
- 5) Get Comfortable. Pick a cozy spot to read with your child where there are no distractions. Try using bean bags or blankets, and don't forget snacks—like waffles!
