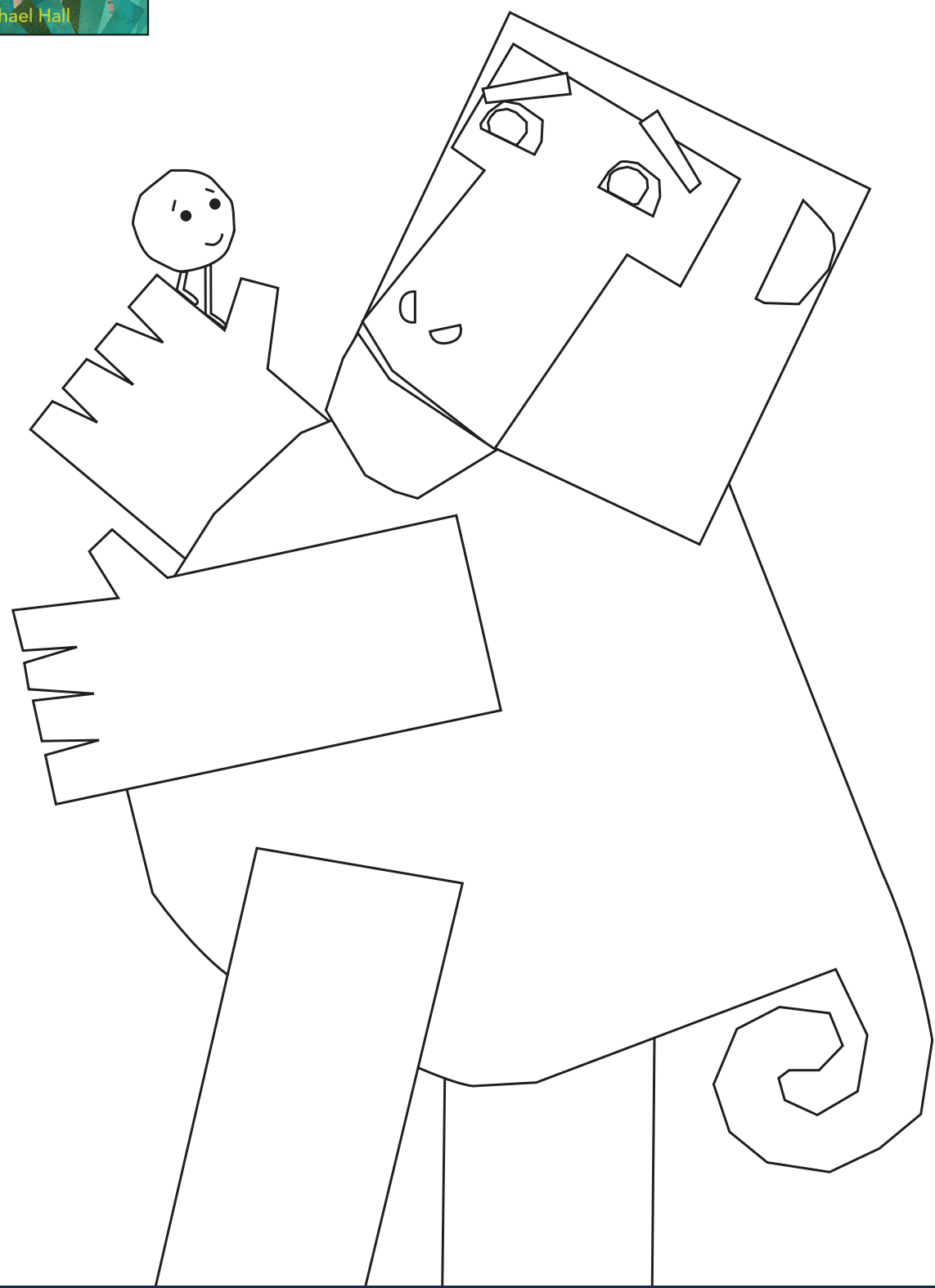




Color in Monkey and his friend Minute!





Count how many minutes there are and write your answers on each tree!

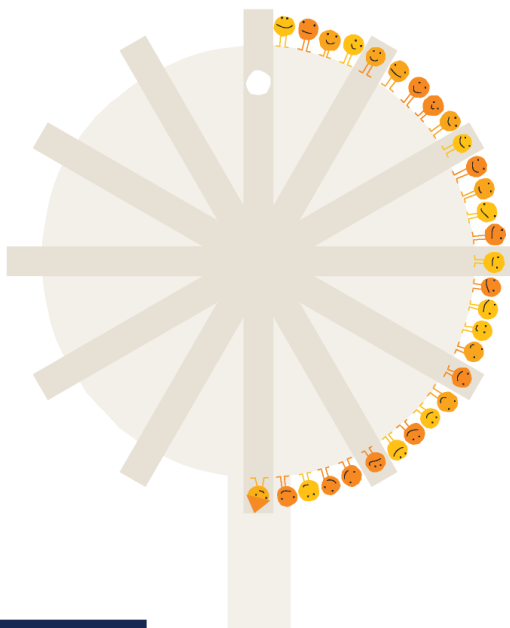
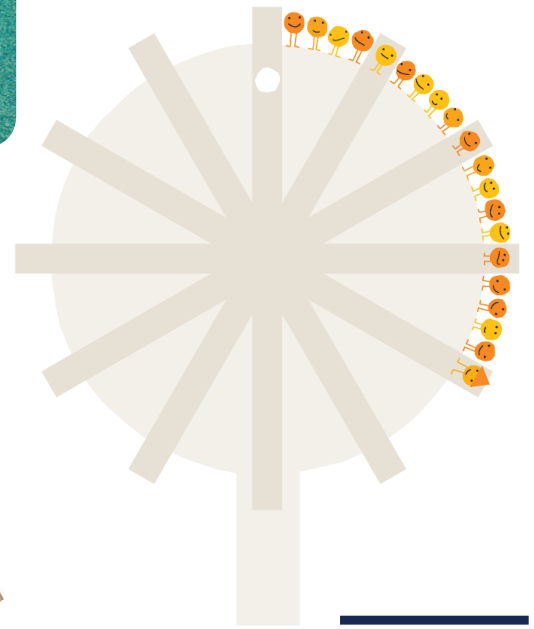
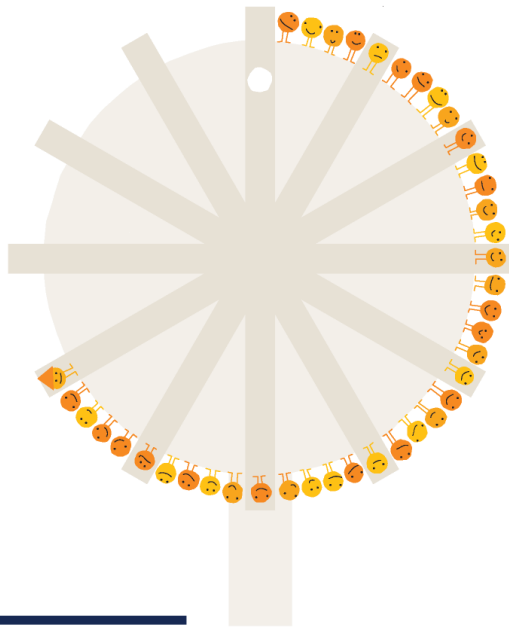
Every hour has exactly 60 minutes in it. Monkey can't count to 60 yet, so Monkey keeps track of time by watching the circle of minutes in his tree fill up. When the whole circle is full of minutes, that means an hour is over.

Measuring Time

60 seconds = 1 minute

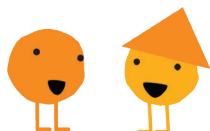
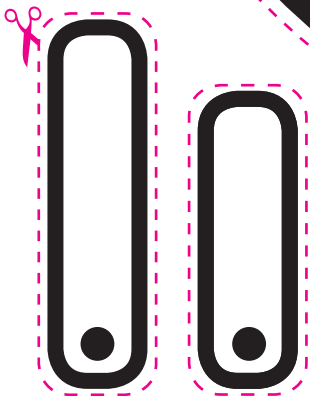
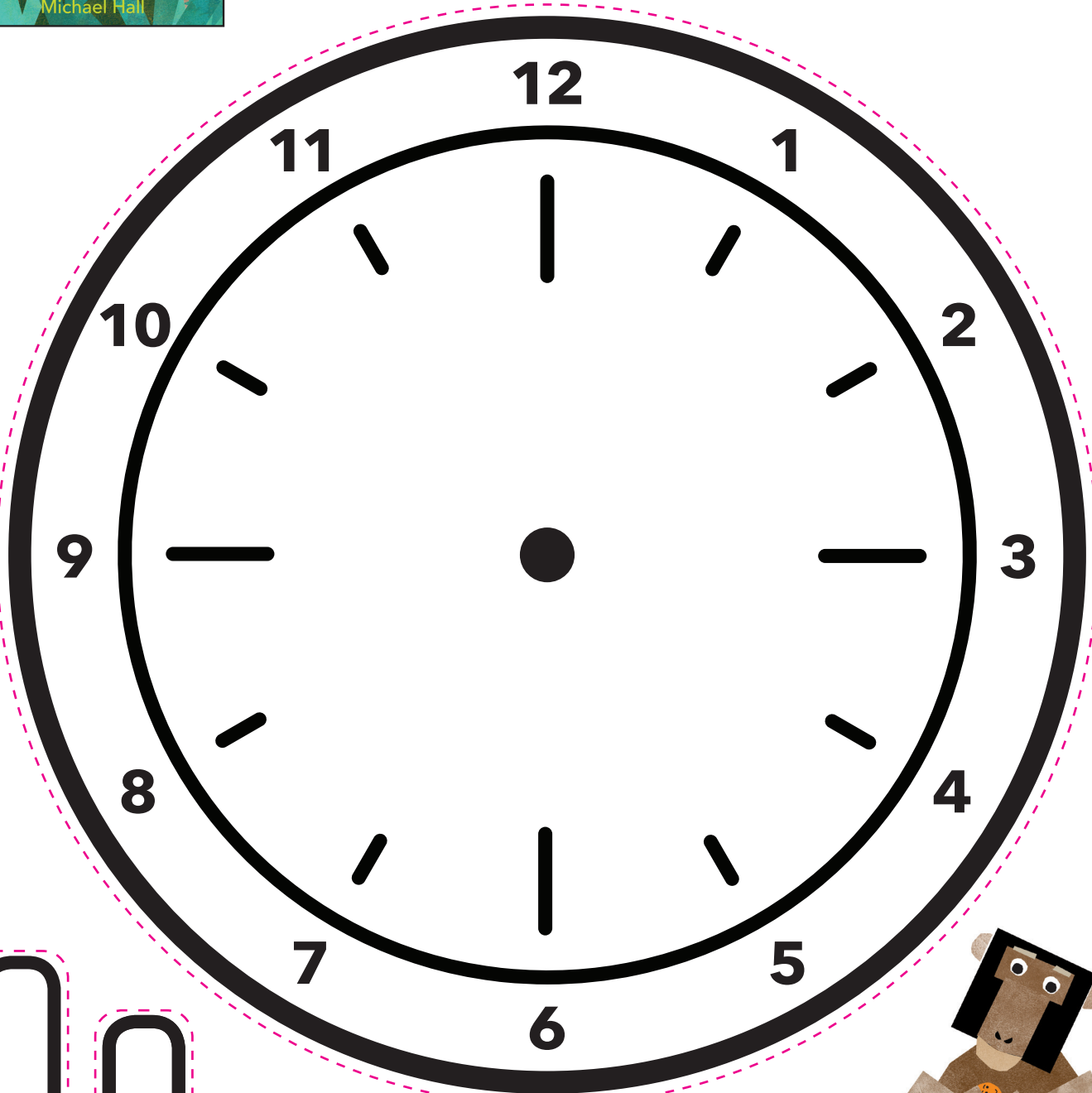
60 minutes = 1 hour
