


## **ABOUT THE BOOK**

- 6. What did you think of the relationship between Sabriel and Touchstone? Did you suspect that there would be a romantic connection between them?
- 7. Did you believe that Sabriel would be reunited with her father?
- 8. How does the Charter work? Does it compare to the religions of our world in any way?
- 9. What purpose does magic serve in *Sabriel*? What are the differences between Free Magic and Charter Magic?
- 10. Why does Touchstone conceal his true identity?
